Main Goals of the UNEVOC Expert Council: Strengthening the capacity of educational institutions and integrating into the global network for the exchange of experience and best practices.

The UNEVOC Expert Council sets its main goal as promoting the development of technical and vocational education and training (TVET) through various types of cooperation in this field.

The main tasks of UNEVOC, such as training qualified specialists and disseminating best practices, and developing and adapting educational programs in accordance with labor market needs, will be the subject of discussion.

Examples of the implementation of UNEVOC's target points will also be presented, and existing problems and challenges in their implementation will be identified.

UNESCO-UNEVOC Centers actively cooperate with the business community, providing students with the opportunity to undertake internships and apprenticeships in modern companies. Examples of successful integration include the creation of educational programs that meet international standards and employer requirements.

Main Directions of Work of the UNEVOC Expert Council:

1. **Direction:** Within the framework of UNEVOC, the implementation of projects for the integration of vocational education and training in accordance with labor market needs, which will improve the quality of specialist training.

2. **Direction:** Studying and assessing the complexity of integrating modern technologies into the educational process, due to the lack of necessary technical infrastructure and insufficient support from local authorities.

3. **Direction:** Prospects for the development of centers for the implementation of innovative teaching methods and strengthening international cooperation to improve the quality of specialist training and their demand in the economy.

4. **Direction:** Systemic cooperation between scientific institutions, universities, institutes, government structures, and enterprises, capable of ensuring accelerated development and implementation of the most advanced technological solutions.

5. **Direction:** Discussion of human resources and infrastructure issues in specialist training, and the deficit of competencies in the field of the modern economy of Sustainable Development.

6. **Direction:** The transition from scientific research to industrial implementation requires overcoming the traditional gap between science and production. Types and forms of reducing such a modern challenge.

7. **Direction:** Training qualified specialists and dissemination of best practices as a subject of discussion.
